

Tourist trip on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the founding of Czechoslovakia



In connection with the significant anniversary of our country, the 100th anniversary of the founding of Czechoslovakia, a joint tourist trip of RPHA employees and their family members took place on 20.10.2018. The planned route in the area of Visalaje, Muroňka, Zlatník and Plato in the Beskydy mountains protected area, 11.6 km long and with an elevation of about 330 meters, was followed by the sunny weather and a temperature of around 12 °C. A total of 26 people attended (of which 11 employees of RPHA), including several children, as well as several animal family members. All the time there was a good relaxed mood, which was enhanced by fresh air in the mountain environment, the employees met the nearest members of their colleagues' families and met each other more. The walk ended with a common late lunch in Visalaje. Due to the positive response, a similar tourist trip will be held next year.
